Presentation/Session Proposal Instructions Proposals Due April 1, 2018

To streamline the proposal review and conference planning process, all persons who wish to submit an abstract or session proposal should do so electronically via email.

To receive full consideration for inclusion in the conference, your abstract or session proposal should be submitted via email and ***include all of the following information***.

- Name
- Company/University
- **Complete contact information**, including mailing address and email address
- **Complete title** of the paper to be presented
- Name(s) of attending co-author(s). Please specify attending
- Name(s) of non-attending co-author(s). Please specify non-attending
- **Abstract** describing the paper to be presented – one or two paragraphs are sufficient
- Please specify attending presenter's discipline/area of expertise (e.g. economics – transportation; urban planning - housing, etc.)

Important Notice: Conference registration fee must be paid by May 1, 2018 or the paper will be removed from the program and will not be presented, even if previously accepted. This is necessary due to the number of people who submit paper proposals, but do not attend and do not provide notification.

Please save your abstract as a Word or WordPerfect file with the name "your last name.mcrsa18" (example: smith.mcrsa18). Attach the file and send it electronically, via email to John Leatherman at jleather@ksu.edu. Faxed or mailed copies are not accepted.
